This is a **Modification** to the **Native Language Preservation and Maintenance Implementation** Program Announcement, **HHS-2009-ACF-ANA-NL-0039**, published to the ACF Grant Opportunities webpage on December 5, 2008. **The application procedures are hereby modified.**

Summary:

Executive Summary: The Administration for Native Americans (ANA), within the Administration for Children and Families (ACF), announces the availability of Fiscal Year (FY) 2009 funds for new community-based activities under ANA's Native Language Preservation and Maintenance Implementation program area. Native Language Implementation grants are used to implement a preservation language project that will contribute to the achievement of the community's long-range language goal(s).

Purpose of Modification: To clarify how to figure the non- Federal share that is required, per *Section III, Part 2 Cost Sharing or Matching* of the PA. Currently, the PA explains the NFS calculation using incorrect figures. Both the Federal request amount and the total project costs are identified as \$125,000, with a NFS amount of \$25,000. To correct the calculation, the Federal request amount should be revised to \$100,000.
